

Policy for the Hiring of Coaches.

Sports are a part of the overall MLHS education program. The motto of the Titan athletic program is "Christian education through athletics." The first priority in the hiring of an ML coach is finding someone who conducts themselves as a God fearing, Christian adult.

The search for a new coach will be conducted in such a way and in such places where a God fearing, Christian adult is likely to be found. Besides behaving in such a way as to bring positive public relations to MLHS, the prospective coach must be able to work with administration in the following areas (the list is not all inclusive):

- Demonstrate exemplary sportsmanship
- Have a high level of knowledge in the sport or be willing to learn
- Be a motivator
- Adjust to working at a small church school
- Accept mentoring
- Be loyal to and support other ML coaches, programs and administration.
- Devotions and prayer as instructed by administration

Interviews are conducted. In the case of varsity head coaches, the athletic administration along with the Administrative Council recommends their top candidate to the Board of Regents.

Concerning all other prospective coaches, they must be interviewed and sign a contract. The administrative council, in conjunction with athletic administration hires these coaches and reports periodically to the Board of Regents.

All individuals who coach, help out, advise, or in any way work with student athletes must be under contract, All coaching contracts are one year contracts.
